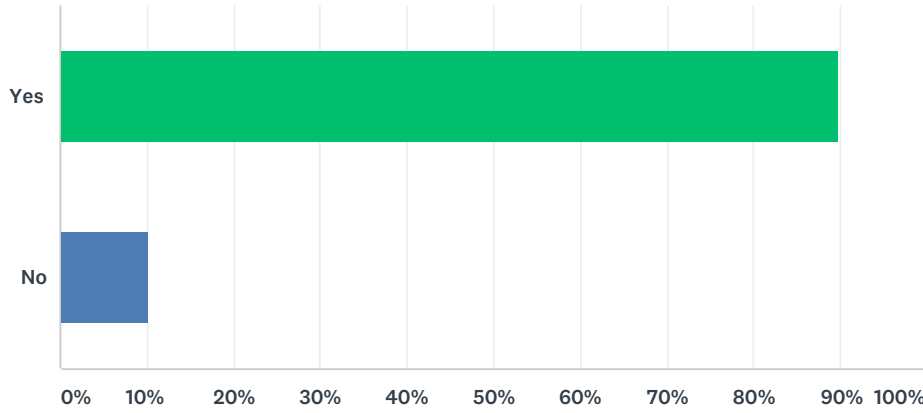


Q1 Does Odiham need dedicated public toilets?

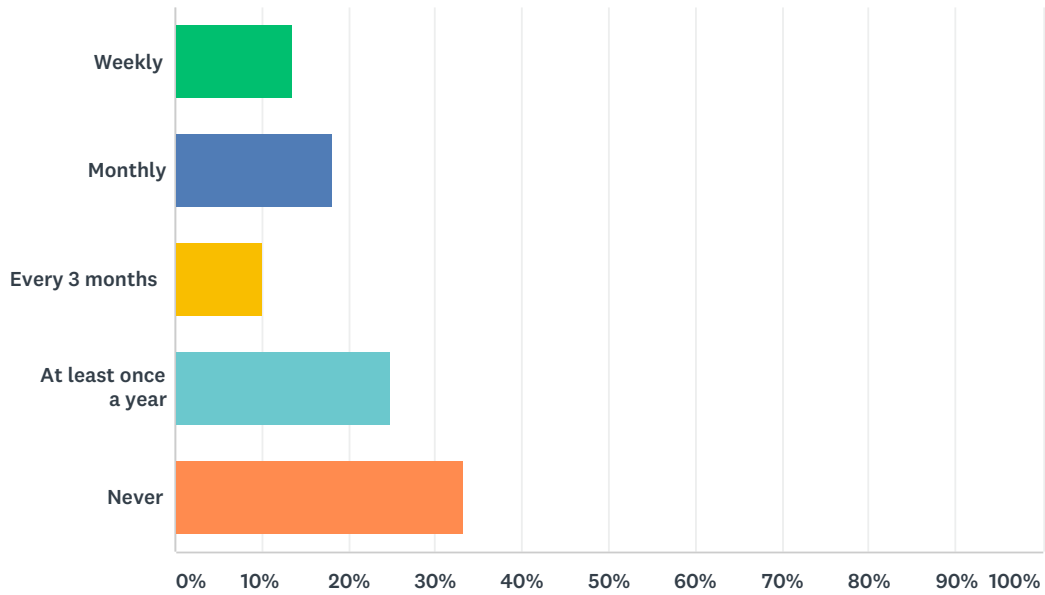

Q2 How often do you use the King Street Public toilets?

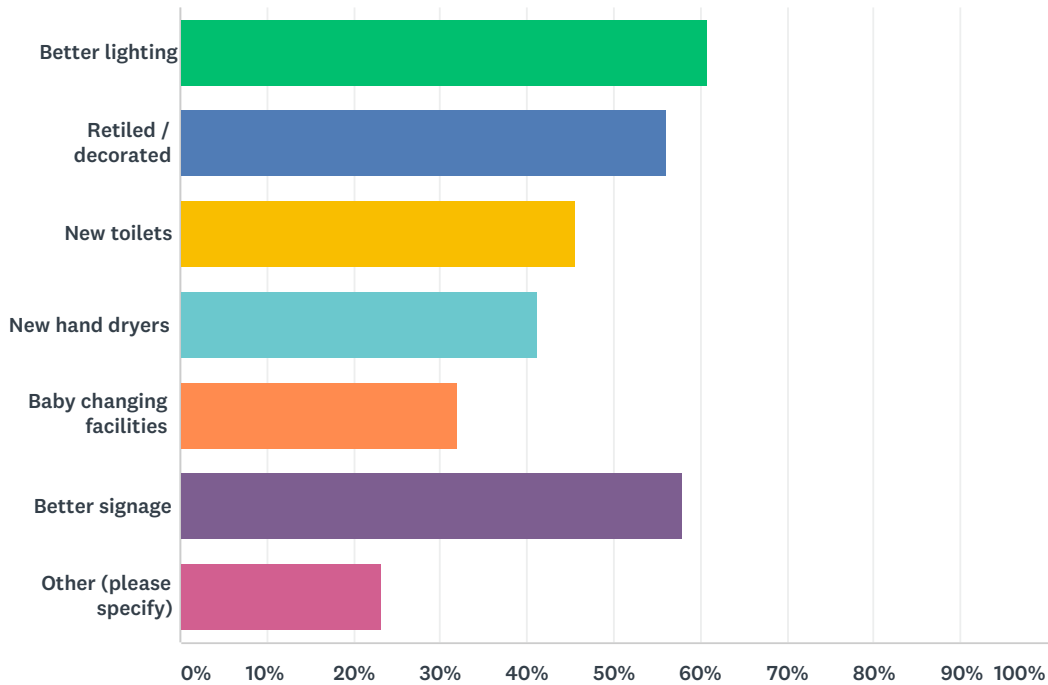

Q3 What refurbishments would you like to see (tick as many as you like)?

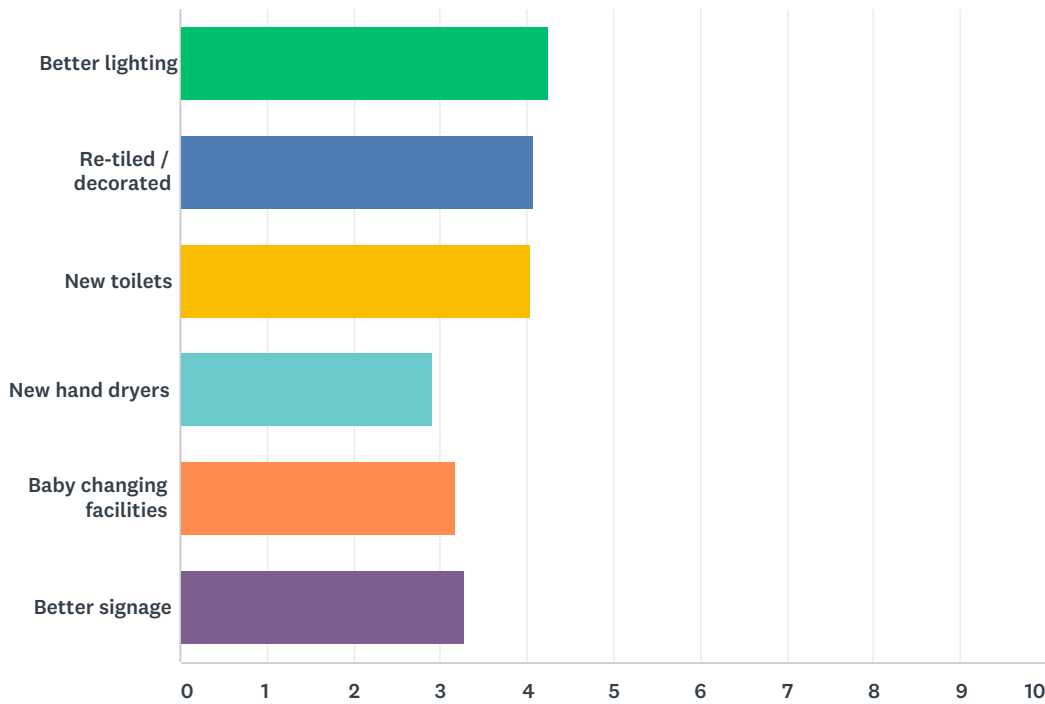

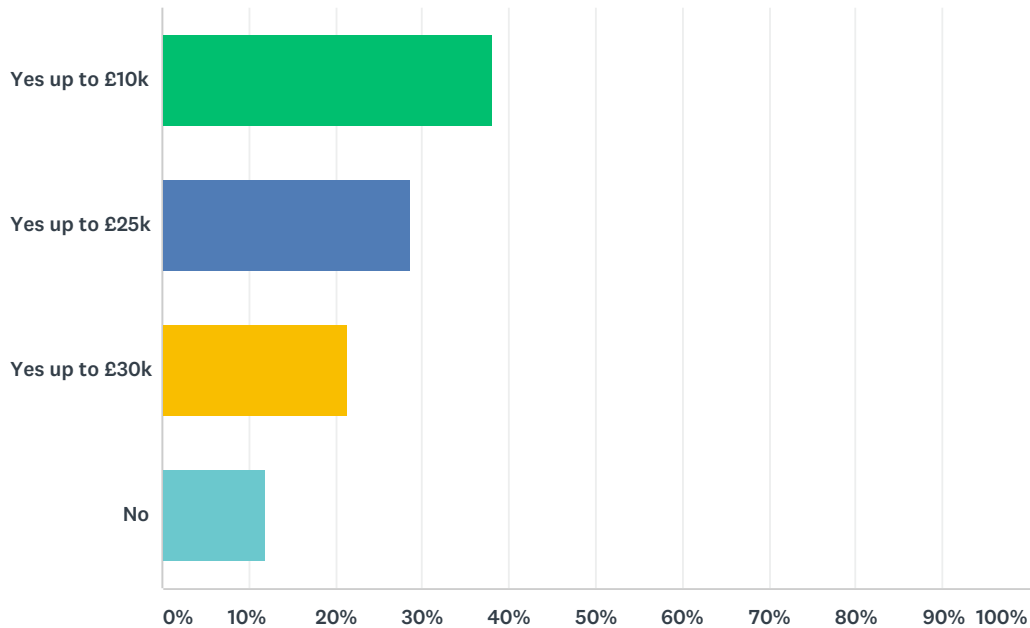

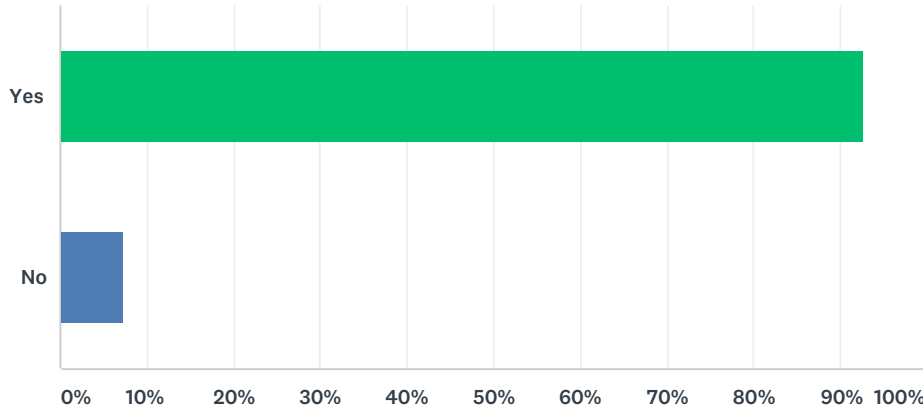

Q6 Should our toilets be open 7 days a week?

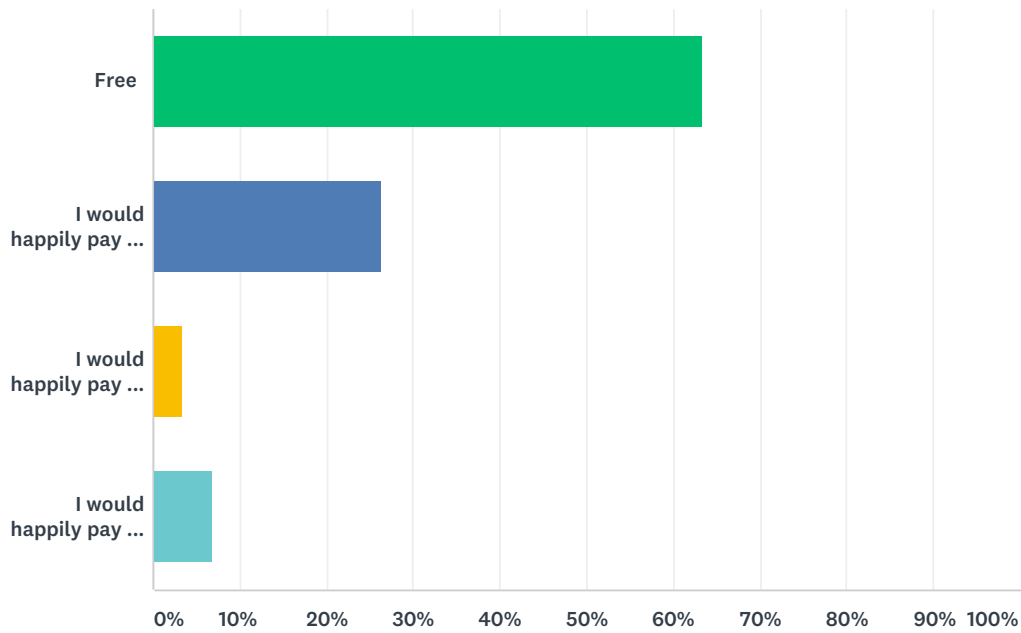

Q7 Should the King Street public toilets remain free or carry a small charge to contribute towards ongoing running costs?

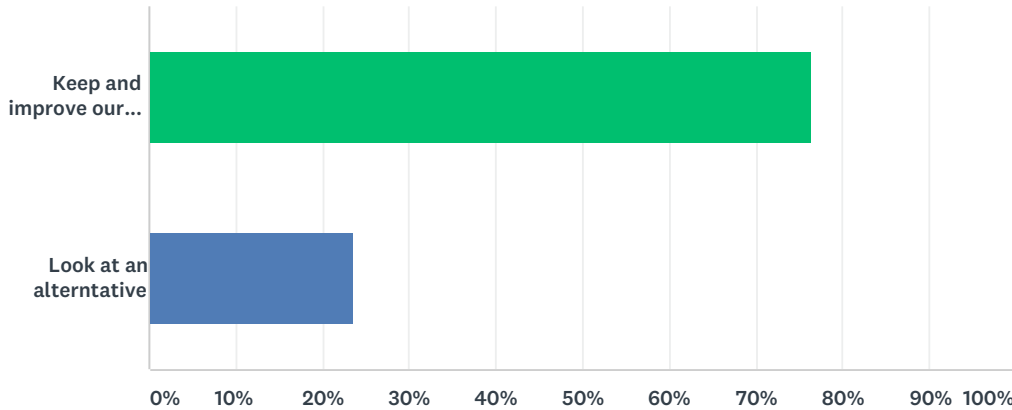

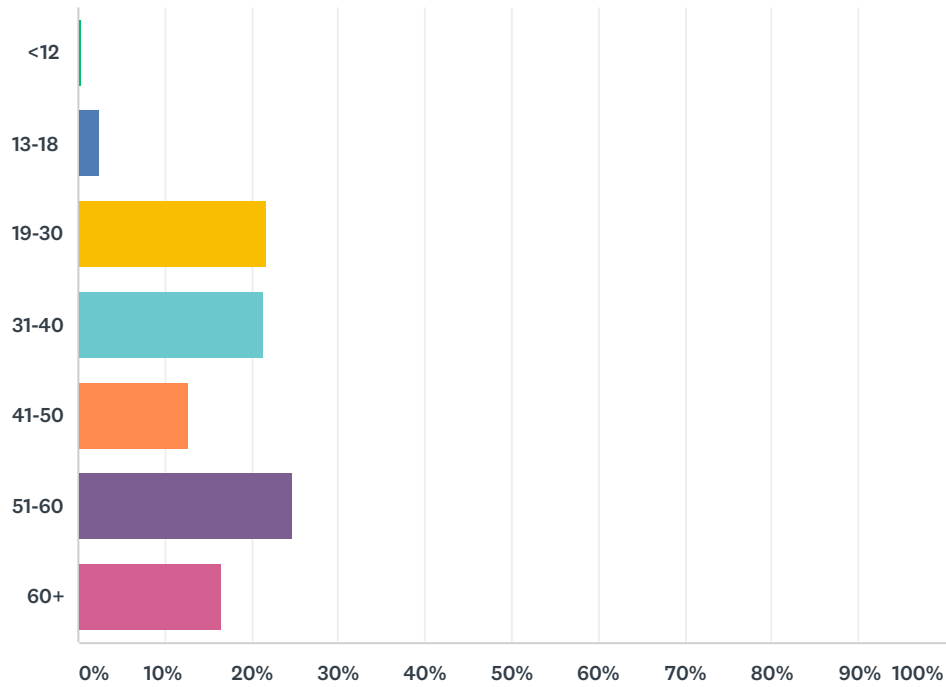

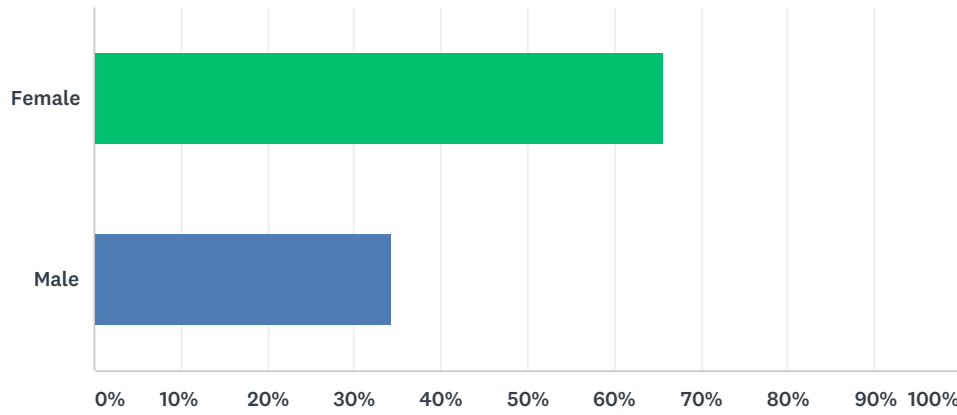
